Welcome to the first ETC Heid's School of Musical Arts Alumni Newsletter! For those who have been out of the ETC loop for a number of years we are glad to have you back!

Luckily for ETC, alumni Bryan Detweiler took the position of All Americans and Rouge Director. Bryan is an 8 year alumni who graduated from Stow High school in 2012. He currently is finishing his degree in Music Education with a concentration in Choral Singing at Kent State University. He was excited to take over the reins but also

nervous as it was his first directing experience. For Main Street, Alumni Michele Hajar took over as director.

Even with all of the change the All Americans and Rouge both posted great years! The All Americans went to five competitions in Ohio and Indiana. They made finals in every competition and won Grand Champions at the Cuyahoga Falls show choir competition in February! Rouge (Which is ETC's all girls high school group if you did not know) went to four competitions in Ohio and Indiana and placed no less than second in the single gender division in three of their four competitions. Their season was highlighted by winning Grand Champions in the single gender division at the Medina Show Choir Competition.

The Main Street Singers had a great year. They went to three competitions in Ohio and Indiana. They ended up winning two Grand Championships and ended their year with a second place finish at the Olentangy competition.

This edition of Alumni Spotlight will focus on Alumni Derric Nolte. Derric was a member of ETC from 2001-2005 while he was a student at Tallmadge High School. He was a singer dancer from 2001-2003 and was a member of the crew in 2005.

Since leaving ETC in 2005, Derric went on to study Theater Design and Production at the University of Cincinnati's College-Conservatory of Music (CCM). After graduating from CCM, Derric moved to New York City and became the Production Assistant for various Broadway shows, including Evita, Annie and Bullets Over Broadway. He became the Assistant Stage Manager on Annie towards the end of the show's run.

I Derric was the Production Stage Manager at Porthouse Theatre in Cuyahoga Falls during the Summer of 2014. He enjoyed being close to home and working for a wonderful theatre



company. In August of 2014 Derric took the position as Assistant Stage Manager with The Book of Mormon National Tour. He has stayed in this role since 2014, and is currently on tour with the show, traveling around North America.

ETC All Americans 2005

The 2005 ETC All Americans started out as an unknown, but ended up being a very successful group. The year began with a much smaller group than the year before. The 2004 All Americans ended the year with 51 members, while the 2005 All Americans began the year with only 35 members.

The group was also a young one with only 8 seniors and 7 juniors. Knowing this there were unknown expectations on how the group would fair. It was never spoken to the entire group, but many felt that if the group just made finals it would be a success.

The group received a strong show created by director Cheryl Boigegrain, Arranger Ron Jones, and Choreographer Mike Weaver. The show was entitled "Elements" and had a loose theme of songs with natural elements in it (i.e. earth, sun, water).

The group decided to travel to four competitions in Ohio, Michigan, and Tennessee. At their first competition in

November they were able to take home 1st runner up behind Teays Valley. At this competition they were able to beat Piqua "The Company", who had become a group that gave ETC fits the last few years. The kids were ecstatic with the placing, with many saying that the competition was one of the most fun they have had in years. The placing jump started the group and gave everyone the confidence that although they were small they had a chance to have a great year.

In their next competition the group ended up winning Grand Champions taking home Best Choreography, Best Combo and Best Show Concept. They did not place in finals in Nashville, but ended their year taking home 1st runner up to an undefeated Teays Valley taking home Best Vocals, an award which Teays Valley had not lost all year.
